Declaration on conflict minerals

Ladies and Gentlemen,

Thank you for your inquiry regarding conflict minerals.

In accordance with section 1502 of the „Dodd-Frank Act“ adopted in July 2010 by the US Congress, companies noted on the US stock exchange are obliged to provide information about their use of so-called conflict minerals. These include tantalum, tin, tungsten and gold from the Democratic Republic of the Congo and its neighboring states (Angola, Burundi, Central African Republic, Rwanda, Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda and Zambia). The objective of this scheme is to stop financing the operating armed groups of the DRC region through raw material extraction and trading. This should be achieved by avoiding raw materials procurement from the conflict regions.

WASI GmbH is aware of its social responsibility in terms of environment, safety, health and observance of human rights.

We do not directly import conflict minerals, neither do we have any information that our products contain minerals that originate from this conflict region.

Please understand that, due to the large amount of enquiries, we cannot complete any special forms. We hope that this declaration contains the required information and we would like to thank you for your confidence and the good collaboration.
